Foreword

Public-Private Health Care Recovery Platform

The Dutch government, through the Netherlands Enterprise Agency (RVO) and on behalf of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, has established three public private platforms to support the private sector in contributing to the reconstruction Ukraine. One key initiative is the Public-Private Health Care Recovery Platform, aimed at aiding the reconstruction and strengthening of Ukraine's healthcare system, which has been severely impacted by Russian aggression.

The platform facilitates collaboration between Dutch and Ukrainian organizations and companies to develop sustainable healthcare solutions for Ukraine. It aims to provide up-to-date information and opportunities through newsletters and platform meetings. By leveraging public-private partnerships, the platform aims to align Dutch initiatives with Ukraine's healthcare needs, promoting sustainable and effective solutions to rebuild and enhance Ukraine's healthcare infrastructure.

The platform comprises of diverse stakeholders from the private sector, NGOs, knowledge institutes, and the Dutch government. It is open to all relevant organizations from the Netherlands who want to contribute to Ukraine's recovery. The Secretariat of the Platform is managed by the Task Force Health Care (TFHC) and the Netherlands Enterprise Agency (RVO). The platform informs the Dutch Life Science and Health (LSH) sector on relevant information and opportunities including financing instruments. As part of the platform activities incoming delegations from Ukraine are supported and connected with Dutch organizations. Furthermore, the platform is in regular contact with Ukrainian counterparts and visits relevant conferences.

Categories of Organizations and Solutions

1. Mental Healthcare

Dutch organizations offer a wide range of mental healthcare solutions to support the mental recovery of Ukrainians affected by the conflict. Solutions include mental health platforms, professionals on a distance and remote consultation.

2. Rehabilitation

To rehabilitate wounded and injured soldiers and civilians a great demand for facilities arises. Solutions include physiotherapy, prosthetics, wheelchairs, crutches, and other aids to support those who have been injured.

3. Diagnostics

Due to the increased demand and destroyed infrastructure the need for diagnostic solutions has increased. Dutch organizations provide (refurbished) imaging devices such as MRI, Echo, and CT scanners, essential for diagnostics. Additional diagnostic solutions include lab tests and personalized medicine.

4. Infrastructure

Healthcare facilities have been damaged and some regions are at maximum capacity. Therefore, hospital and clinic infrastructure are needed. Both on an ad hoc basis and long term. For the ad hoc basis the Netherlands offers modular hospitals and mobile facilities which can be rapidly deployed to increase capacity where needed.

For the long term rebuild and refit of care facilities the Netherlands offers expertise in hospital design (conform European standards) and hospital build. Think not only of the building itself but also about lighting, lead walls, installations and helipads.

5. Telehealth care

Remote care solutions include video consultations and monitoring platforms. These allow medical consultations from a distance or even from abroad to increase capacity for medical professionals. Dutch technology offers platform software, sensors, and devices to support telehealth care.

6. Healthcare system development

Dutch organizations offer advisory services on how to develop healthcare systems (conform EU standards). Furthermore, multiple organizations offer (online) training and schooling programs for medical professionals to build capacity.
